Chile is the 3rd longest country in the world, paled by the imposing Andes Mountain range through the Pacific Ocean, by valleys filled up with rivers, lakes and lagoons. It has infinite diverse environments and landscapes and is considered amongst the best places to do fly fishing due to the purity, abundance and quality of its waters. These virgin waters, born from the great southern ice field, are home to a diverse range of species which make for fantastic fishing opportunities.

Species include: Salmo Trutta or Brown trout (highly prized by fishermen for its bright colors), Brook trout or "Fontinalis", Rainbow trout, Chinook salmon (King Salmon), Atlantic Salmon, Coho Salmon and endemic fish such as Peladilla. Patagonia offers remote locations with stunning scenery which are free from contamination and boast excellent 'active' waters. We invite you to try your luck and skill to conquer some of the most pristine and Singular fish that we could find!

Aguas marinas (year) 0,2 Uf = \$4.600 CLP

 Aguas continentales (year) 0.3 Uf = \$ 6.900 CLP
 Aguas marinas y continentales (year) 0.4 Uf = \$9.200 CLP

FOREIGNERS (NON RESIDENTS)

Aguas marinas y continentales (week) 0.5 Uf = \$11.500 CLP
 Aguas marinas y continentales (month) 1.0 Uf = \$22.900 CLP
 Aguas marinas y continentales (year) 1.5 Uf = \$34.300 CLP

Chileans or residents over 65 years old, under 12 years old and handicapped are exempt of paying/obtaining this license.
