Friday

Reception at airport and transfer to hotel.

Return to the hotel. Dinner is on your own account.

Saturday

The day starts when the expert picks you up at the hotel for visiting Benegas Winery, founded by Federico Benegas Lynch. It was built in 1901. Lunch is at the exclusive Domaine du Mont Country Relais. This place invites you to relax in a 100 year old Victorian house; built with the traditional adobe and pinotea wood. The house sits on 2 hectares of cultivated land located in the heart of Maipú. Then we'll visit the boutique winery Clos de Chacras. This winery founded by Baptist Gargantini in 1921 employs high technology in a memorable environment. In the tasting room, we'll taste their award winning premium wines. Return to the city of Mendoza .

At night dinner is at 1884 Francis Mallman Restaurant.

Sunday

Zuccardi Winery is a family business founded in 1963 located in Maipu. It makes great wines with high quality and innovation. We will visit the vineyards and taste the wines. Lunch is at Zuccardi's restaurant.

Late afternoon transfer to the airport for departure.
