

## TOUR DESCRIPTIONS Cali, Colombia

## CITY TOUR: Half Day

Today's morning tour with private guide will highlight the main features of the country's third largest city. Cali was founded in 1536 and remained a small Andean town until the boom in coffee and sugar came along.

Located at over 3000 ft. above sea-level, climate varies little, generally hot and humid. There are two dry seasons (Dec-Mar and Jul-Aug), rest of the year is more often than not the wet period; average temperature is about 75F.

Some of the major sites are the colonial neighborhood of San Antonio, with the chapel at the top of the hill providing nice views of the city; Plaza San Francisco is one of the city's largest brick plazas. It is a city with a vibrant nightlife and well known for it "salsa" dancing clubs.

## BUGA: Full day tour with lunch

Full day tour with private guide that will begin with a visit to Hacienda "El Paraiso, where Jorge Isaac was inspired to write his novel "La Maria," On to the colonial town of Buga (dating from 1555) for visit the Basilica of "El Senor de Los Milagros" (Lord of Miracles), to which thousand make a religious pilgrimage every Easter.
