

Endemic creatures will amaze you. Get ready to discover unique wildlife for the first time.





## GALAPAGOS ENDEMIC




A typical day on a luxury Galapagos cruiser like the Endemic includes a morning expedition to a visitor site to see:

Cap this off with a cold drink on the sky deck while watching a dazzling sunset and you have the perfect Galapagos day! The Galapagos **Endemic** has an **enviable itinerary**, making visits to all of the most **remarkable visitor sites** the islands have to offer.

Some of the more memorable visits on our itinerary include **Punta Espinoza** (Fernandina Island), home of the extraordinary **Flightless Cormorant** and a teeming colony of marine iguanas.

Snorkeling trip off of majestic Kicker Rock, where fortunate guests may see a school of hammerhead sharks, and a stop at North Seymour Island to see nesting Frigate Birds and Blue-footed Boobies as well as sea lions and the elusive land iguanas.
